## **Grantee Contract Summaries**

### FF184EL23582 SOFTEC Education Inc

DWD issued a grant of \$60,401.00. SOFTEC Education Inc will provide Virtual Reality Heavy Equipment training on a CAT VR Simulator to 8 trainees over 6 weeks.
