**Grantee Contract Summaries**

DWD issued Tradesman Inc. a grant contract up to \$45,050 to partner with Justin Gardner, a lecturer at UW-Eau Claire, to develop a customized training program to train 40 incumbent landscaping and grounds keeping workers. In addition to installation of irrigation systems and basic lawn care instruction, trainees will learn general leadership, sales, and service skills. Training is anticipated to run approximately 4-5 months, based on the skill level of the trainees.

DWD issued UniteMKE, Inc. a grant contract up to \$10,377 to train ten (10) unemployed Community Health Workers (CHWs) and ten (10) incumbent existing CHWs with their collaborating partners Caring for Community and Center for Self Sufficiency Care Coordination Agencies (CCAs). Training is focused on effectively using the Care Coordination Systems software. Trainees will participate in one (1) 20-hour session.
